I am the staff attorney reviewing above captioned temporary rule.

On line 17, as written, "aggregating employment at any of these employers" applies only to community college institutions, and not (A) or (B). Was that the intent?

On lines 23-24, as written, "for at least 1,040 hours, aggregating employment at any of these employers, during the previous 12-month period" applies only to community college institutions. Was that the intent? This seems very different from the current temporary rule in which the 1,040 hour requirement was applicable to all employers.
