Thanks again for the 1-day extension, for your insights as we revised our adopted rules, and for confirmation that we had satisfied your concerns. This email addresses two things: (1) your technical change requests, and (2) notice of changes pursuant to 26 NCAC 05 .0107(b)(2).

1. Your requests for technical changes: The only change you requested on 12/22 that you have not prereviewed is 07F .0102(3). There we made the change you specified

Enclosed are the technical corrections to the 07F Rules as shown below:

name.

NOTE: Full legal names, full first names, and full middle names shall not include nicknames.
