The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

Generally, to the Rule: As written the rule provides when wildlife "may" be taken. What statute or rule prohibits the taking of wildlife (deer) in the absence of regulatory permission?

G.S. 113-291.2 authorizes the WRC to set seasons. 15A NCAC 10B .0201 specifies that "no person shall take, or have in their possession, any wild animal or wild bird listed in this Section expect during the open seasons ..."

Page 3, Lines 6 and Line 30 and Page 4, Line 15: Is the State regulating the use of dogs in this statute or regulating the Commission's authority?

Both. Most of G.S. 113-291.5, regulates the WRC's authority to restrict the use of dogs. However, it also regulates running dogs during the closed deer season.

Page 3, Lines 13, 20, 24, 30, and 33, and Page 4, Line 1: "Blackpowder" does not appear to be a word notwithstanding its definition in the rule. Ought it not be "black powder"?

This rule has been around a while. We believe that historically, it was one word, but it appears that now, it's more common as two. However, our constituents know and understand "blackpowder". It's even written in our regulations digest that way. We would prefer to keep it as one word at this time.
