Thank you for the responses and revised rules.

I have one final request in 10K .0102 (c). Please incorporate by reference the standards of the International Hunter Education Association into the rule. I believe this is needed after reviewing 150B-21.6 and the style guide.

Pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.6, an agency may adopt by reference in its rules, without repeating the contents of the material in the rule if: (1) the agency is incorporating another rule or part of a rule the agency has already adopted; or (2) the **agency is adopting a code or standard that another body has adopted**. Incorporate a document created by an outside organization to allow your agency to enforce those requirements without repeating the contents in rule. Provide a cross-reference instead if you are simply pointing out a relevant document or citation.

The agency shall designate in the text of the rule whether the incorporation includes subsequent amendments and editions of the referenced material. The reference shall also state where copies can be obtained and inspected. If the material can be accessed for free online, then provide a URL in the text of the rule, and state "may be accessed at [URL] at no charge."

I suggest starting a new sentence after "Association" that reads, "The standards of the International Hunter Education Association are incorporated by reference, including subsequent amendments and editions, and can found be at iheause.org/resources/#Standards at no cost." Be sure to remove the hyperlink to the website when incorporating materials available online.

Good morning Mr. Wiggs,

I wanted to introduce myself. For the past 18 years I have been the water safety rulemaking coordinator at the NC Wildlife Resources Commission. I work in the Enforcement Division. I coordinate the boating safety rulemaking procedure for the 10F Rules in the North Carolina Administrative Code. I also analyze and prepare the text for the one hundred or so 10F Rules for readoption, revision, or repeal during the Periodic Review of Rules.

The Wildlife Resources Commission's statutory authority for water safety rulemaking is found in NCGS 75A-15. While the Rules Division and Rulemaking Coordinator have oversight of agency rulemaking processes, the water safety rulemaking process as defined in NCGS 75A-15 is quite different than the hunting, fishing, trapping, and game land rulemaking that normally is done during a set regulatory cycle and handled by the Rules Division. Fore more than 25 years the water safety rulemaking process has been handled separately by a water safety rulemaking coordinator.

Water safety Rules are adopted throughout the year, independent of the regulatory cycle, for these mostly *local* water safety Rules. Applications for water safety rulemaking are received from counties and municipalities or are initiated by the agency. Water safety Rules are promulgated only to mitigate hazards to boating and water recreation safety. We work with the US Army Corps of Engineers for concurrence to promulgate Rules in federal waters, Tennessee Valley Authority, the U.S. Coast Guard, as well as with other state and local agencies on matters of preliminary safety assessments, local laws of the General Assembly that may prevent rulemaking in the NCAC, permitting questions and regulatory marker placement questions. I prepare fiscal notes, and work closely with Wildlife Enforcement for their guidance as to whether requests for regulation may be necessary and whether they conform to our statutory authority. I write the Rule text and present the applications to the Wildlife Commissioners for their consideration throughout the rulemaking process. I schedule and hold public hearings for each proposed 10F Rule in conformance with the APA. Upon final adoption, the Rules are sent from the Rules Division to your office for final review by the Rules Review Commission.

In my capacity as Water Safety Rulemaking Coordinator, I attend Rules Review Commission meetings when 10F Rules are under consideration. Could you please make sure I receive an invitation to the RRC meeting on January 31 at 10:00 and to other RRC meetings during the year? Should I request this from someone else?

Also, may I please be added back to the email list from the Office of Administrative Hearings, for requests for technical changes for the Wildlife Resources Commission, so I may respond directly to your questions that pertain to 10F Rules? <a href="mailto:Betsy.haywood@ncwildlife.org">Betsy.haywood@ncwildlife.org</a>.
