Explain:			
As a result of a cold stun event and in accordance with the North Carolina Spotted Sea Trout Fishery Management Plan, the N.C. Division of Marine Fisheries (NCDMF) issued a proclamation closing the recreational and commercial harvest of Spotted Sea Trout in joint and coastal fishing waters until June 15, 2025. To alleviate angler confusion, the proposed amendments closed the Spotted Sea Trout harvest until June 15, 2025, in waters within NCWRC's jurisdiction (Inland Fishing Waters and hook-and-line in Joint Fishing Waters) to be consistent with the NCDMF closure. Since noticing the rule, the NCDMF has issued another proclamation closing the season until June 30, 2025.			

7. Why is adherence to notice and hearing requirements contrary to the public interest and the immediate adoption of the			
rule is required?			
Changes are needed to be consistent with the NCDMF closure, alleviating angler confusion and protecting the resource. The initial proclamation was issued January 22, 2025, and the second proclamation extending the closure was issued April 8, 2025.

5	(b) The minimum size limit is 14 inches.

8	(b) The temporary amendment shall expire on June [15,] 30, 2025.
