Thank you for speaking with me today. The following is a memorialization of the topics discussed. If you find it not to be accurate or wish to add anything, please respond to this email.

- The tracts within the Pisgah Game Land (PGL) are owned by either the United States Government or the State of North Carolina. The State land was acquired through the processes of government acquisition controlled by the State Property Office at the Department of Administration. The property is acquired by deed and is reflected on the respective County GIS maps.
- Wilson's Creek is a geographical area within the PGL and the boundary is not set as a tract but rather is an understood area.
- Line 18: That which is an "authorized use" is posted on signage at the trailhead. A trail can be on both state and federal property through its course. Arguably 150B-2(8a)(f) might permit this in lieu of a rule.

Additional Questions:

Does the Commission determine the boundaries of the Pisgah Game Land?

The boundaries of Pisgah Game Land are determined by the US Forest Service and the Wildlife Resources Commission. Pisgah Game Land consists of property primarily owned by the US Forest Service and voluntarily enrolled in the Game Land program, but some parcels are owned by the Commission.

Does the Commission determine the boundaries of the named tracts?

Named tracts are determined by the property owner.

Does the Commission determine the boundaries of the "Wilson's Creek portion?

The Game Land along Wilson's Creek consists of property owned by the US Forest Service and property owned by the Commission. The proposed amendments to 10D .0260 regulate recreation on the Lutz Tract, which is owned by the Commission.

What are the "authorized uses" of posted trails? Where is this defined?

There are trailheads on WRC property that connect to trail systems on property we don't own (e.g., US Forest Service lands) and we don't want to prevent people from accessing these trails or limiting their ability to recreate on those connecting areas. Trailheads connecting to systems off WRC property list the types of uses that are prohibited.

The Rules Review Commission staff has completed its review of this Rule prior to the Commission's next meeting. The Commission has not yet reviewed this Rule and therefore there has not been a determination as to whether the Rule will be approved. You may email the reviewing attorney to inquire concerning the staff recommendation.

In reviewing this Rule, the staff recommends the following changes be made:

Generally, to the Rule: There are various "tracts" named in the rule. In what rule are the tracts defined?

The boundaries of individual tracts are not defined in rule, instead maps are publicly available and free of charge on our website. Our constituency is accustomed to referencing maps when recreating on our properties

Line 6: Where is "Pisgah" Game Land defined?

Game Lands are generally defined in G.S. 113-129 as "Lands owned, allocated to, leased, controlled, or cooperatively managed by the Wildlife Resources Commission." Pisgah Game Land is a national forest owned by the US Forest Service and cooperatively managed by the Commission. Like other state agencies tasked with land management (e.g., NC State Parks, NC Forest Service), the boundaries of individual properties are not defined in rule, instead maps are publicly available and free of charge on our website.

Line 11: How are the trails "designated"?

Trails are marked on game land maps and posted at their trailhead.

*Line 11: How does the public know if a trail is designated?* 

Designated trails are marked on game land maps, and our constituency is accustomed to referencing maps when recreating on our properties. The public is generally accustomed to looking at maps and reading signs at recreational properties.

Line 18: Define "activities."

We have reworded the rule, removing the ambiguous term "activities" and mirroring language currently found in 10D.0102(b).

The Wildlife Resources Commission is the owner of the Lutz tract and as described in 15A NCAC 10D .0102(b), can authorize entry on game lands for purposes other than hunting, trapping, or fishing.
