Hi all,

I'm the attorney assigned to these rules, which will be considered at the July 31, 2024 RRC meeting. I don't have too many questions, so I am going to just put my requests for changes in this email. As the meeting is on Wednesday, your responses are due no later than 5 PM on Monday, July 29, 2024.

15A NCAC 10C .0307

My understanding is that this rule applies only to flounder, as an inland game fish, when it is found in inland waters, and wouldn't apply to joint waters. Is that correct? This rule applies to inland fishing waters and joint fishing waters. Per 10C .0301(b), Flounder are an inland game fish when found in inland fishing waters. However, because the WRC and MFC agreed that the laws and regulations pertaining to inland game fishes apply to joint fishing waters (10C .0106(b)), the size and creel limits for flounder apply in inland and joint fishing waters. Along those lines, must this rule be jointly adopted by MFC? No.

I think we have some formatting issues. I don't think the language that was proposed for deletion and restored needs to be italicized, just highlighted. Also, I don't think you need to put "<u>one</u>" in brackets, as it is text being added, so it just needs to be underlined and highlighted. As discussed, this rule was amended as part of our annual rulemaking cycle and the new version (one fish limit) will not become effective until August 1. Since we had to notice off of the version that is currently in the code, which is not the most recently approved version, we were

asked to italicize the text we proposed to change. We should have put a note in the form to explain that. I apologize for the oversight. The current proposed temporary rule only changes the season dates.

15A NCAC 10D .0252

On line 4, should "game land" be capitalized? Lower case is consistent with the other 93 game lands in the 10D .0200 rules.

Also on line 4, why is "Seven Days per Week Area" capitalized? Consistent with the definitions in 10D.0103(j).

In your History Note, change "2023;" to "2022;" to remain consistent with the original effective date. Fixed.
